2003 Status Report on Project NExTMAC
Description of Activity:

In 2003 we continued with the professional development project that we began with a 1-year CMS Endowment Grant in the previous year. On 13 June 2003 (immediately prior to the CMS Summer Meeting) a 1-day workshop was held at the University of Alberta. The workshop, aimed at junior faculty, included sessions as follows:

- Jim Stewart (McMaster) spoke on "How to Enliven the Mathematics Classroom"
- Catherine Podeszfinski (NSERC) presented some information on how to apply for Discovery Grants
- Brian Alspach (Regina) and Jonathan Borwein (SFU) led a panel discussion on Supervising/Advising Students and Research Projects
- 3M Teaching Fellowship winners Andy Liu (Alberta), Miroslav Lovric (McMaster) and Peter Taylor (Queen's) shared some of their insights about teaching mathematics.
- A group discussion on topics related to teaching first year math courses.

Participants were also warmly welcomed by CMS President Christiane Rousseau (Montréal) and CMS Past-President Jonathan Borwein (SFU). At the end of the workshop, some books and other resources, addressing issues pertinent to junior faculty, were distributed. (The books were those that were left over from the previous year.)

We were disappointed at the low turnout at this year's workshop. Although we had preregistrations for 11 participants, only 3 people showed up to participate. Some of our registrants were attending the workshop on "Connecting Women in Mathematics Across Canada", two of whom joined our workshop in progress once the Connecting Women workshop finished on Friday afternoon.

Still, the anecdotal feedback which we received from those who did participate was very positive. One of the participants even volunteered to write a short exposition for

inclusion in the CM	S Notes, to report on t	the workshop and to	help get the	word out about

We are committed to hosting a third workshop, timed to coincide with the CMS Summer Meeting at Dalhousie University in June 2004, and we are already discussing and making plans for the sessions.
