The Caratheodory–Cartan–Kaup–Wu theorem on an infinite-dimensional Hilbert space

Let Ω be a bounded convex domain in a separable Hilbert space. Let $f: \Omega \rightarrow \Omega$ be a holomorphic mapping with a fixed point p . We give a criterion, in terms of triangularizability and spectral properties of df_p , for f to be biholomorphic. This is joint work with Joseph A. Cima (Chapel Hill), Kang-Tae Kim (Pohang University of Science and Technology, Korea), and Steven G. Krantz (Washington University, St. Louis).
